AMCP Foundation has introduced the [Nested Knowledge](#) platform for use in the 2026 Annual National P&T Competition. All participants should create individual accounts at nested-knowledge.com to be invited to an organization. Follow the steps below to gain access and begin work on the drug monograph tables:

- *Clinical Evidence Tables*
- *Comparative-Effectiveness Evidence Summary*
- *Cost-Effectiveness Evidence Summary*

1.) Each Competition Coordinator will need to request a code to create an account on the [Nested Knowledge](#) platform. (Only one code should be requested)

To request a code for your school, email Nested Knowledge: support@nested-knowledge.com.

Your email should include:

- Your Name
- "School Name"
- Email address

***Teams hosting local competitions, please set your school up as School Name Team no. 1 and so on. (Example: College of Hard Knocks Team no. 1)**

2.) The Competition Coordinator should use the code to create an organization (use your school name).

3.) The Competition Coordinator will invite team members to access the platform. The Competition Coordinator is responsible for granting access to all team members.

***All participants should create individual accounts at nested-knowledge.com to be invited to an organization. Follow the instructions on the next page to set up individual accounts.**

Key Definitions

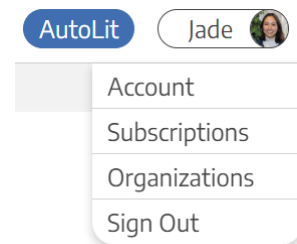
- **Nest:** an updatable, collaborative review project
- **AutoLit:** the workflow section of NK, where you conduct searches, screening, and data extraction
- **Synthesis:** the output section of NK, where interactive data presentations are automatically generated and tables are exported

Step 1: Create yourself an account

- Visit the [Nested Knowledge](#) site, hit Sign Up and follow the [instructions](#)
 - After your email is verified, you will use the same site to Sign in
 - If no verification email is received, check your spam folder
 - Still no verification? [Email NK support](#) to verify

Step 2: Join your organization

- Admins should navigate to [Organizations](#) → Invite Members → Input emails
- Users should receive invite by email or navigate to [Organizations](#) to accept
- Once you have access, you can view all nests on the [homepage](#)
